<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Upon arrival, the operator screened licensing staff for Covid-19.</p> <p>The children and operator were outside playing when licensing staff arrived. The children were engaging in free play activities on the deck and then moved down to the lawn to explore the crushed gravel and bubbles. The children were seen sharing along with the assistance of the operator. The operator encouraged problem solving and sharing during indoor play, as well as, outdoor play.</p> <p>After outdoor play, the children and operator returned inside. The children first explored books and then had a dance party. The children especially enjoyed "freeze dance." It was very evident that the infants have played "freeze dance" before as they anticipated "freezing" when the music stopped.</p> <p>The indoor and outdoor environment were very welcoming and inviting. There was a variety of play materials which allowed for lots of choice.</p> <p>When observing in the indoor play environment, the operator showed licensing staff a climbing apparatus that the children love to climb on. When licensing staff asked if the operator has the manufacturer's manual for the climbing apparatus. The operator replied that she did not have the manual. Licensing staff asked the operator to obtain the manual online and to not use the "picklar" as a climbing apparatus until she can locate a manual and ensure the apparatus is recommended for infants.</p> <p>Thank you for the lovely visit.</p>
