| Comments: While inspecting the laundry room, licensing staff noted that there is a locked cabinet for toxic materials, such as cleaning supplies. Licensing staff also noted that some toxic materials (spray foam insulation, bug spray, etc.) were stored up high and out of reach of the children however, all toxic materials are required to be stored in a cabinet that is secured by a lock and key.
