General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at 8:30 am in order to see the children's morning activities. One of the infants was home due to illness and the potential illness form was ready for the child's return. Upon arrival the 18-month-old infant who was present was eating her snack. All food is sent from home. After snack the infant painted on her highchair tray, then the Operator cleaned up and proceeded to the larger space set up for gross motor activities. Some of their inclusion and diversity grant was used to buy more materials such as a tracing table that lights up and jeweled blocks that were very colourful and the inside sections could be used as a kaleidoscope. The gross motor section was set up as an obstacle course of foam blocks and music was put on for dancing. One of the infant's favourite activities was climbing, a little staircase between rooms and when outside the larger stairs on the deck. While in the larger room a deer was spotted in the back yard.

Outside play was in the back yard with a fenced in deck that is set up for the children's play. We walked through a small, wooded section and came out on the edge of the golf course and spotted the deer again. In the back yard the crocuses were starting to bloom and there were two small climbers with slides that the infant enjoyed climbing with help from the Operator. There was a great interest in climbing stairs and the beginning of more complicated verbal expressions besides yes and no.

After outside play the Operator read books to the child and prepared for quiet time. The child went down easily for her nap that takes place in the morning only. The Operator is very responsive to the child's needs and interested in her development and likes and dislikes. Child guidance was patient and kind, and every learning opportunity was noted and added to. The home is well set up for the children's use and most of the downstairs is set up and child proofed for the children.
