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General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at Play with Purpose Childcare to conduct the annual renewal inspection. Upon arrival, the children were preparing for a walk to a nearby park. They put on their outdoor shoes, sun hats, and gathered their water bottles. The operator placed the infant in a stroller while the older child walked alongside. During the walk, the group took their time and stopped to collect natural items to bring back to the home. At the park, the children asked to visit the wooden bridge to look for fish in the stream. After they lost interest, they transitioned to the playground. Throughout the visit, the children were observed climbing on the play structure, using the swings, and going down the slide. Before returning home, the operator encouraged the children to walk up the grassy hill, then secured the infant in the stroller for the walk back. When the group returned home, the children's diapers were changed as needed, and everyone washed their hands. Due to the expected high temperatures later in the day, the children had a late morning snack on the back deck. Several large trees provide shade over most of the deck, creating a comfortable outdoor space. The operator explained that the infant typically naps mid-morning, so the group transitioned indoors. While the infant slept, the older child participated in a variety of crafts and free play activities. At lunchtime, the operator completed a quick cleanup before gently waking the infant. The group decided to have lunch outside on the back deck. Positive child guidance practices were observed throughout today's renewal inspection. The children appeared comfortable with the daily routine and had a positive relationship with the operator. The indoor environment was welcoming, bright, and thoughtfully arranged with a variety of natural materials. Required files and documentation were well organized and readily accessible. A discussion was had with the operator regarding professional learning hours. Please ensure the required PL hours are completed by the end of the month. Licensing staff will provide additional resources and support by email. Licensing Staff recommends for Renewal.
