General Comments					
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children in the 2-year-old class were napping while the 3- and 4-year-olds were down the hall watching a short video. Educators announced to the children they had a few more minutes of the video before transitioning back to their shared classroom with the 2's. Once back in their classroom the 3- and 4-year-old children did a short circle time in which they sang songs, went over the calendar and talked about the weather. The children got to choose a book they would like to read together, they chose "Baby Canada Goose Flies South". Once the book was finished, they had a class discussion about birds and the reasons why they migrate. An activity was set up for the children at the tables that included pictures of birds, a variety of books on birds, feathers and bird nests. Children were also observed drawing and coloring birds. Other children were seen playing with cars and blocks before washing hands for afternoon snack.					
All classes were observed washing hands for afternoon snack. Tables were cleaned and floors were swept as the children finished eating. Each classroom spent time playing outside in the fenced in area. The children were seen balancing on tires, playing with balls and playing in the sandbox. The rooms are clean and offer a variety of materials for the children to explore. In each classroom, age-appropriate artwork was displayed in addition to current learning stories. Family pictures and photo albums of the children playing with peers and engaged in activities were displayed throughout the classrooms. Only					
positive child guidance was observed during the visit. Educators were attentive to the children's needs, showing excitement and interest in the children's activities.
