General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were engaged in a variety of activities as they waited for their peers to arrive for the day. Families were greeted and children were signed in at morning drop off. The indoor environment was clean, organized and welcoming. Age-appropriate materials were observed in each classroom. Current learning stories and pictures of the children were posted throughout the facility.

In the school aged classrooms, the children were engaged in board games at the table. One group was observed playing "Sorry", "Guess Who" and "Jenga". At another table, a small group of children were building with an Electronic Kit "Electronic Snap Circuits". The school age children broke into 3 small groups, taking turns in the gym and classroom. A guest came in to do a "Chinese Dragon Puppet" activity with one group while another did a coding activity.

In the preschool classrooms, the children engaged in tabletop activities before washing hands for morning snack. After snack, the 3/4 class prepared to go outside while the 2-year-old class gathered to sing songs and do an activity, hot vs cold. The children were observed smiling and laughing as they sang songs. After the class activity, the children used the washroom, sunscreen was applied, and water bottles were filled. Roll Call was done, and a head count was observed before the children transitioned to the outdoor play space. Outside the children were observed using the slide, scooping, pouring and building in the sandbox and collecting elements of nature in bowls. The Reading Tent- United for Literacy was set up outside. The children sat and listened to "Blackflies" by Robert Munsch. After the story, the children sat together and colored pictures at a nearby picnic table before transitioning back inside to prepare for lunch time.

The transition back inside the facility was smooth. Extra staff were present throughout the morning to offer support during transition periods. Hands were washed as the children entered the classroom and sat down to eat lunch. As the children ate, one Educator was observed setting up nap mats and blankets while the other Educator sat at the table with the children. Staff files were reviewed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The files were organized and contained all required documents. Only positive child guidance was observed. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children, were observed comforting children when needed and offering praise. A conversation was had with the Operator regarding the outdoor play space. Please add
