Monitoring Inspection completed today. During monitoring inspection, a power outage occurred. QA Monitor discussed with staff on site requirements when a power outage occurs.

Children were engaged in an activity in the gym at the time of the inspection, following a presentation provided by the Belleisle Watershed Coalition. Children were observed engaged in the game.

Improvements were noticed in the indoor play area. Clearly defined interest centres, and a variety of materials were available and easily accessible for the children. Summer programming was posted on the parent board highlighting activities that educators had planned for the week.

As discussed, for the fall, QA Monitor recommends that educators use the planning form created and currently used by the main club. This form provides opportunities to identify children's interests, reflect on experiences, and involves the children in the planning.

Photos and children's art work posted throughout the room, provide children with opportunities to develop a sense of belonging to their space and revisit past activities.

Educators report that children are only using the lower playground for play as the metal play structure in the upper playground still requires repair.
