General Comments

Monitoring inspection completed today.

Children were observed in the indoor play environment and preparing for outdoor play.

A variety of materials have been added to the indoor play environment and clearly defined interest centres are present. Materials are accessible for the children to independently choose activities.

As discussed with educator on-site, the use of video games is not a best practice. If children are provided with opportunities to play video games, it is to be balanced with other activities and time limits are appropriate for the age of the children.

Discussed with on-site educator that attendance records are to be complete, showing all absences and detailing the reason. In the event of a communicable disease outbreak at the facility, the Department of Public Health may ask to see all attendance records.

In the outdoor play environment, ensure that surfacing under play structures and swings used by the club is raked to appropriate depth daily in order to meet licensing requirements. Playground safety checklist observed to not be completed since April. Regularly completing playground
