### General Comments

Purpose of visit was for annual renewal inspection. Children were engaged in several activities throughout the visit. The indoor play space has been rearranged since last monitoring inspection and is well maintained, organized and clean. Children were observed participating in both independent play and cooperative play. Materials in the home are plentiful and activity areas were well defined. Space allowed for long term projects with wooden building blocks to be left out for children to continue working on throughout the day. Children also enjoyed the tent which was set up in the corner.

After self-directed play, children were asked to wash their hands and get their lunch boxes. Snack time was observed, and independence was encouraged by the operator as she modeled for children how to open their snacks and open and close the zippers on their lunch boxes. Operator sat with the children and engaged in pleasant conversation and modeled appropriate table manners.

Documentation of learning was visible throughout the home with artwork posted and new materials and books were being added to the home based on the children's interest. The children had created a learning web about dogs as this is a new emerging interest of the children.

After snack each child in attendance chose a book which the operator read to them as a group. The children all enjoyed the stories and were very engaged. The children had a lot to say about the stories after they were read, and the operator encouraged these conversations and questions.

The outdoor play space was well maintained and safe with activity areas that were inviting. The use of natural materials within the space encouraged creativity, independence and exploration of nature.

Home can be recommended for licensing.
