## General Comments

When I arrived, the children were playing. One group was doing activities around Aboriginal Day and the other group was playing and then went outside. Eventually both groups went outside until lunch time. Then the children came in from outside washed their hands and had lunch. During lunch the staff sat with the children and engaged in conversation with them. After lunch the younger children had nap/quiet time and the older children did some quiet activities and then eventually went outside.

Staff were engaged with the children. Positive child guidance was observed such has gentle reminders and encouragements.

The Centre is clean and there are materials to meet the children interest and different learning needs such has materials to support individual and group experiences, literacy, materials to express creativity and problemsolve.

The outdoor playground has mostly natural elements and meets all the regulations. The children were using shovels to dig up worms to put in the flower pots.

Please ensure all child profiles are completed in full. One child file was missing a Medicare number and medical practitioner information.

Diaper changing procedures are posted on the wall, however, it does not contain all the steps required as per the Public Health diaper procedure guidelines, therefore, I would ask that it be replaced with the Appendix 22 of the Operator Manual.

The New Brunswick Curriculum Framework encourages a clutter free environment, I would recommend that the Centre be decluttered. There is allot of materials and resources for the children but are not visually appealing to the children because of excess of materials around. The Operator advise they are working on decluttering and finding a solution for storage to be able to store things away from the classrooms.
