General Comments

Monitoring visit
Administrative records were observed. Attendance is tracked and staff info was reviewed.
Upon arrival school age children were playing quietly. They had a short day at school due to a community power outage. This center did not get the power outage, but since schools were closed, school age children were on site.
Other children were observed napping on cots and 2 children had just woken upon arrival. When all children woke up, they were observed washing hands, toileting and moving into afternoon activities. All children were sitting at tables playing with loose parts and practicing mark making and printing their name. Educators were observed sitting at the table with the children. The school age group were using their imagination while playing with play mobile characters. They were using different voices as they interacted with the characters and played with their friends.
I did not observe outdoor play during my visit, but I did overhear and educator say after we eat snack ywe will be going outdoors.
Lots of positive interaction observed between children and educators. One educator was observed participating in the children's imaginary play experience. A lot of the play was about having no power. Children were reacting to the news about the community experiencing a power outage today and pretending how that would effect ordering food at a restaurant.
The operator has intentions about making a change to her service at the end of October. Before the change can take place please submit your Change in Service application to your QA.
Licensing staff did follow up with the Operator regarding an email about staff wages. The Operator was happy to advise this issue had been resolved.
