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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Learning stories, artwork and pictures of the children were on display on the walls in the stairwell and into the classroom. The indoor environment was bright, tidy and organized. Upon Licensing Staff arrival, the preschool age children had just transitioned back inside and were sitting down for afternoon snack. One Educator was heard offering assistance with opening containers and wrappers while the other Educator was hanging up the children's outdoor gear.</p> <p>The transition from snack time to free play was smooth. As the children finished eating, they packed their personal belongings into their bookbag and lined them up against the wall in preparation for end of day. Several children were observed smiling and laughing at the wrapping activity. At the table the children had the opportunity to practice wrapping gifts. Several boxes, paper, elastics, bows and ribbons were available for the children to use. Later in the afternoon a large group of children were observed building houses using magnetic tiles. The children extended their play by adding figurine people and cars.</p> <p>An Educator was observed greeting the buses as the school age children arrived. The Educators used Walkie Talkies to communicate to one another and let them know who was absent. As the children transitioned inside, personal belongings were hung up, and hands were washed before having afternoon snack. The children have been very interested in skip rope lately. Children names and their high score was observed on a large whiteboard. The children sat and cheered on their peers as they waited for their turn to skip. Once snack time was finished, the children cleaned up and prepared for outdoor play.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children and engaged in their activities and conversations. Each child has a hook and label with their name and picture for personal belongings and a basket for mittens, hats etc. Various resources and materials were accessible to the children on low, open shelves. All play materials were in good condition.</p>
