Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that a first aid (FA) certificate and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate in 1 of the 12 employee files verified is not a level C certificate. The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file. During the inspection, the administrator informed the inspector that the employee is conducting their first aid (FA) and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) course today.			
20 For the purposes of section 17 of the Act, the requirements with respect to the transportation of children are as follows: (c) the driver of a motor vehicle and the motor vehicle must be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act.	20(c)	Feb 01, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection the inspector observed that 4 out of 5 vehicles are in compliance with Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act. The fifth vehicle could not be inspected because it is currently at the repair shop. The vehicle must be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act before it can be used to transport children.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that a first aid (FA) certificate and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate in 1 of the 12 employee files verified is not a level C certificate. The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file. During the inspection, the administrator informed the inspector that the employee is conducting their first aid (FA) and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) course today.			
26(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall require the parent or guardian referred to in subsection (1) to sign a declaration confirming that he or she has read and understood the content of the handbook.	26(2)	Jan 27, 2023

The child's file must include the signed statement from parent confirming they have read and understood the parent handbook.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (b) permitting, in the case of illness or soiled clothing, the child to shower or bathe or showering or bathing the child.</p>	27(b)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (c) permitting the administration of medication in the circumstances set out in section 46.</p>	27(c )	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for administering medication is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for administering medication is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (f) permitting the child to participate in an outing.</p>	27(f)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for outings and excursions off premises is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for outings and excursions off premises is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (g) transporting or providing for the transportation of the child.</p>	27(g)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for transporting the child or providing transportation is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for transporting the child or providing transportation is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (i) releasing information about the child to an outside organization.</p>	27(i)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for releasing information about the child to an outside organization is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for releasing information about the child to an outside organization is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (j) permitting photographs and videos to be taken of the child for publication or social media.</p>	27(j)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication on social media is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication on social media is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (k) posting photographs of the child at the licensed facility to illustrate the child's learning.</p>	27(k)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for posting photographs of child in the centre to illustrate learning is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for posting photographs of child in the centre to illustrate learning is provided by the parents.</p>			
<p>39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;</p>	39(2)(a)	Jan 24, 2023	Jan 24, 2023

<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed 2 bottles of Windex on a shelf in the classroom. Cleaning products must be locked up and inaccessible to children. During the inspection, the administrator placed the bottles in a locked storage room. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.</p>	40(1)(a)	Jan 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the inspection, the inspector overserved that 7 out of the 10 water bottles verified were not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that water bottles are labelled with the child's name in order to prevent and control the spread of communicable diseases and illness.</p>			
<p>50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child in- volved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.</p>	50(2)	Jan 25, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the administrator informed the inspector that minor incident such as scraps or small cuts are not recorded. The operator must ensure that an incident log is recorded when incidents that do not require emergency medical attention but may require minor first aid (for example, bumps, scrapes, minor cuts and bites).</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the arrival of children at the facility, snack time, indoor free play and tae know do. The inspector observed that the orientation of the children is done in a positive and respectful way and that while participating in tae kwon do classes, the children are very engaged.</p> <p>During the inspection, the outdoor play area is covered with snow, therefore the inspector could not verify if more than one kind of material allowing different types of activity is offered. It is recommended not to use the large play structure in the park since the ground is frozen. The park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the permit delivery team.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
