Comments: When Quality Assurance Monitor arrived at the facility to take the ratio, she noticed that the daily attendance records didn't reflect on the number of children present in the classroom. At certain time of the day, some children go to Tae Kwon Do class, and some stay in the classroom. The attendance record sheet must follow the children. The operator must ensure that the attendance record sheet is accurate at all time.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance monitor verified</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If children's personal belongings are easily accessible, labelled with the name of the child, only used for the intended child and stored separately for each child. - Child guidance - Storage space for toxic products - Daily activities <p>Quality Assurance monitor was able to observe the children do Tae Kwon Do and play indoors.</p> <p>She had a discussion with the operator regarding daily activities. The same calendar of activities is used for all the classrooms. Daily activities must respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child. QAM recommends that each educator's daily program includes a variety of activities planned according to the ages and development of the children.</p>
