Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the outdoor play area is icy, and snow covered creating a slipping hazard. The operator must ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 3 books are damaged. During the inspection, the administrator disposed of the books. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jan 17, 2024	Jan 15, 2024
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observed that 3 out of the 10 water bottles verified were not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that water bottles are labelled with the child's name in order to prevent and control the spread of communicable diseases and illness. During the inspection, the administrator labelled the children's water bottles. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Jan 17, 2024	Jan 15, 2024
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector found that 2 out of 6 lunch boxes are not labeled with the child's names. All food brought from home must be labeled with the child's name. During the inspection, the administrator labelled the children's lunch boxes. Deficiency is now compliant.			
49(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that the guidance of the children receiving services at the licensed facility is positive and includes positive reinforcement, encouraging efforts and recognizing accomplishments.	49(1)	Jan 15, 2024

<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector heard an educator say: "it's not nice, we don't scream", then told the child to go sit on a chair because they were not listening. It is not permitted to send children to a cot, mat, time out chair or corner. Positive child guidance techniques must be used to support and encourage children in learning independence and appropriate acceptable behavior. These practices help to develop relationships that promote children's well-being and sense of belonging. The Operator must ensure that all staff members read Section 8.2 Child Guidance of the Operator Manual for Full-time and Part-time Early Learning and Childcare Centres.</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed indoor free play, snack time and Tae Kwon Do classes.</p> <p>During the inspection the ground was snow covered; therefore, the park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the licensing team. The use of the outdoor play structures is not recommended as the ground is frozen and does not provide protective surfacing.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
