Comments: One of the three audited child files does not have contact information for the emergency contacts. All child folders must contain 2 emergency contacts with complete contact information to ensure pick-up within the required hour.

Comments: The doors to a storage room is locked with a grip and twist door knob cover which can be opened by some children. The room contains unsafe items (gym equipment, pellet stove, radio place on ledge from which electrical cord is accessible to children). This door must be locked with a key lock.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Sep 01, 2021	Sep 01, 2021
Comments: The slide structure in the playground did not have any protective surfacing. The operator removed the structure from the playground. Deficiency is now compliant			
33(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment that includes the following information: (a) the review and repair dates; (b) the action required and the action taken; and (c) the name of the staff member who conducted the review.	33(3)	Sep 07, 2021	
Comments: A monthly review and maintenance plan is not being completed. The operator will create this document containing: the review and repair dates; the action required and taken; and the name of the staff completing the review and send a copy to the Inspector.
