A monitoring inspection was conducted today. Children were observed during snack and outside play.

Discussions were had regarding the Caterpillar toy that is in the outside play area. The children indicated that they are not allowed to jump off this anymore but can climb on it and through it.

Discussed proper child guidance with the educators and they indicated that redirection is working much better. We discussed the environment as the third teacher and have engaging inviting invitations for learning as well room arrangement both inside and outside can help eliminate challenging behaviors.

Discussed Professional Learning that the educators have been taking. I asked the educator, which one these new learning opportunities that she was going to start implementing into her practice at the centre and she indicated that she was very interested in Risky Play. Discussions were had regarding Risky Play, planning of this, types of risky play and if permission slips would be required from the parents. Resource material is being emailed to the facility to give ideas regarding Risky Play.
