General Comments
A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. Children were observed inside and outside. Inside - children were observed during free play. A group of children were observed sitting at a table with their educator, participating in a drawing game. Other children were observed practicing their printing skills, by searching for interesting words, on covers of books, and then printing those words, on paper. Children were also observed sitting together for calendar / weather time. Educator was observed reading a story to the children. Children were observed asking questions, and making comments, throughout the story. Handwashing was observed before and after snack. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility - learning stories, open ended art pieces, and webs. Positive child guidance techniques were observed - educators providing choices, anticipating children's needs, preparing children for transitions, and providing appropriate supervision. Outside - several activities were available and accessible for the children- ride on cars, rock kitchen, climber, balls, trucks, etc. Children were observed climbing and playing in the rock kitchen.
