Educators were observed getting down to the children's level in play and conversation. This is a good example of Well-Being- Belonging-Respectful and Responsive Relationships. With this educators have active involvement with the child in a safe and secure environment.

Conversations were had with the operator in regards to approved licensed space. Facility is licensed for children ages 15 months - 12 years. No children under the age of 15 months are permitted to attend the facility. In order to have children attend under 15 months of age a separate rest area /room is required.
