General Comments

A monitoring inspection was conducted today.

Children were observed in both inside and outside play. Discussed with educators the wearing of masks in common areas IE Hallway and washrooms. Discussed with operator and cook snacks/meals and the use of utensils to serve snacks to the children. Recommended reviewing the COVID 19 Guidelines from December 16, 2020 regarding food handling and serving.

The educators were observed very engaged with the children. Getting down to their level in play and conversations.

Discussed with operator having access to items such as past attendance sheets and daily information sheets when licensing staff comes in to the facility. Discussed having a binder in each room that the educators can put the last weeks in and leave in their learning environments. This is a recommendation not a requirement. It may

make it easier for licensing to access if the operator is not at the facility and access to this information is required for licensing.

A great improvement was seen in the school-age room. Each group has been divided with shelves and the children were observed respecting the bubble grouping and engaged in activities in their own areas.
