<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection was conducted today.</p> <p>In the infant room documentation supporting the children's learning is displayed for the children to revisit. The children have been engaged in playing in the snow, snow painting, sensory play. The children's art is displayed throughout the room.</p> <p>In the 2/3 year old room the children's current interest is Arctic animals. Their art of Arctic Foxes is displayed on the wall. There are learning stories documenting the children's learning: Dressing themselves for outside play, sorting, and building with blocks are also displayed on the walls of their learning environment. On the door as you enter the learning environment there is an igloo as well as Arctic animals and their names displayed.</p>

General Comments

The 3/4 year old room has multiple topics of interests happening at one time: Measurement, Dinosaurs, and Igloo/Snow. Webs supporting these interests are displayed on the wall as a giant tape measure, a dinosaur and on the window. Children's learning is documented in the learning environment in the form of pictures, learning stories and art activities. A Tuff Tray has been added to the environment and the educators indicated they have many ideas for invitations for learning in this new area.

No school-age children were present during time of monitoring inspection but observations of the room show that the children have been participating in a variety of both inside and outside activities. The educators have documented planning evident and children's art and learning are displayed throughout both school-age spaces.

Educators were observed engaged with the children, down at the level in play and learning. Educators were observed speaking kindly and respectfully to the children and tending to their needs. The children were observed happy and content in their environments and with their educators.
