General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed during inside play and snack.

Infants - Educators were observed sitting on the floor with the infants. Infants were observed playing with musical instruments. Infants were observed smiling and laughing, while shaking their musical instruments. Children were also observed looking at books and playing with balls. Diaper changing procedures were observed and followed.

2/3 Room - Children were observed taking part in a variety of activities - painting, play doh, climbing, and playing with binoculars and toy animals. Educators were observed sitting with the children, using positive language, and providing children with choices. The 2/3 group has recently started a unit on Family / All About Me. A sensory bin was observed, with family pictures, and each child also had an individual homemade book, with everything about them, inside.

3/4 Room - An educator was observed reading a story to the children in the cozy reading corner. Educator was observed asking the children questions throughout the story, and children were observed sitting, listening, answering questions and providing comments. Educator stated that the children are presently very interested in building, animals, and coloring. An animal sensory bin was observed, and an animal display was also observed on the window. A conversation was had with educator and operator regarding coloring sheets. Coloring sheets can be given occasionally, when requested, however, there needs to be ample white and colored paper available, at all times. Coloring books are not permitted.

Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Positive child guidance techniques were also observed - educators speaking in a kind positive manner, educators at the children's level, educators providing adequate supervision, and educators offering a variety of choices to the children. All rooms were set up with several well-defined learning / play centers, and each center had ample materials and supplies.
