General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on June 2, 2025.

Children were observed during outdoor free play, engaging in activities that reflected their current interests, including playing ga ga ball, drawing with chalk outside, and participating in group playground games. Educators noted that the children have recently been very interested in being active outdoors. During the observation, educators were seen using positive language and giving gentle reminders, and they played an active role in supporting and facilitating the children's activities outdoors.

The facility maintains a daily incident log and ensures that parents of children present at the center have unrestricted entry at any time. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted, and evacuation procedures are posted in a prominent location. The facility offers a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Drinking water is made available to children throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth.

A conversation took place with the Educators to discuss the strengths and needs of the facility. Strengths identified include the educators' efforts to provide opportunities for extending the curriculum outdoors and to create both individual and group experiences for the children. However, some needs were also discussed, specifically the importance of ensuring that the parent board is posted during programming hours so that the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance are displayed in a clearly visible and prominent location.
