Comments: 2 children's file on 8 children's files verified have emergency contacts that are not within one hour distance. The emergency contacts must be able to respond within one hour if parent(s)/guardian(s) cannot be reached. 4 children's files on 8 children's files verified do not have the city for the emergency contacts.

Comments: The operator is using her own children's attendance record sheet. The daily attendance records of the children must be recorded on forms provided by the Minister.

Comments: Detergent and Borox (used to make slime) are stored in a cupboard over the washer and dryer. Inspector informed the operator that those products must be stored in a locked area. The operator stored the products in a locked area. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Oct 28, 2022	Oct 28, 2022
Comments: The storage space for the personal belongings of each child were not labelled. The operator had labels already prepared with the children's name, they were installed for each child's storage space. Deficiency is now compliant.			

### General Comments

During the renewal inspection, the preschool children were observed during free play, snack time (smoothie with soda crackers) and during outdoor play. The operator had story time with both the preschool and afterschool

children.

The afterschool children painted their own pumpkin and made crafts.

Inspector discussed with the operator regarding the protective surface under the climbing dome in the outdoor playground. The operator confirms that the protective surface "mulch" has the appropriate depth; however, the mulch needs to be tilled.
