<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on February 22, 2022 to conduct the license renewal inspection.</p> <p>On the day of the licence inspection visit the indoor play environment was extremely clean and very organized. All staff files were complete with the required documentation.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed positive child guidance during the inspection visit. The children were observed engaged in activities of their choice. Licensing staff heard lots of rich conversation between the children and educators. There was a lot of discussion around the Olympics and what fun things the children did with their families during the long weekend.</p> <p>While licensing staff was reviewing the children's files, it was noted that most files were complete however, not all files contained complete information (address and phone numbers) for the emergency contacts named for each child. Please ensure that all information is complete for the named emergency contacts in the children's files.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed a large bottle of bleach and toilet bowl cleaner being stored in the bathroom behind a</p>

cabinet that had a plastic child safe lock. All toxic materials are required to be stored in a closet or cabinet that is secured by a door with a lock and key. When this was brought to the attention of an educator, the educator moved the toxic materials (cleaning supplies) in a closet that is secured by a lock and key.
