General Comments

Children finished snack this morning and then got ready to go outside. Each of the children used the washroom and then put on their sunscreen. Children that sprayed on their sunscreen stepped outside with educator's supervision to spray it on. The children in and out were reminded to get all their exposed body parts with a visual and verbal reminder. The educator helped some children rub it in and washed their hands between each child. Children were asked before heading out if they had everything they needed such as hats, outdoor shoes, sunscreen, going to the washroom, and having a water bottle. The educator modelled wearing a hat stating she was putting it on. One child started out and had forgotten outdoor shoes and the educator kindly asked them to grab them to bring with them to change respecting the child.

The educator brought out pencil crayons, paper and paint as several of the children were coloring pictures and others like to use the paint on the outdoor easel.

The children were very independent outside. Some children enjoyed playing in the space set up for ball games while others were searching and playing with bugs, coloring pictures, painting, and playing in the rocks.

Ensure any tires without holes get some holes drilled in them as there was standing water in several tires. There are a couple of boards missing from the bottom of the shed and the children got the ball stuck in there several times, replace these boards. The basketball hoop is in need of repair. The children found a cigarette butt on the playground which they quickly gave to the educator. A sweep of the outdoor area each morning will protect against any unsafe items.

The inclusion support worker supported the classroom and one child. She was responsive to the child's needs. The educator was observed to be very respectful to children asking them if they needed support, talking about their day, and including them in ideas. She mentioned they are a group interested in fitness and crafts and she has plans to incorporate these interests over the summer with obstacle courses and some new craft items.
