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<p>General Comments</p> <p>There has been changes in staff in the school age room and the educator who has taken over has just recently started. The room has been uncluttered and is more organized. To ensure that more defined learning centres are created for the school age children, more shelving may be required. The administrator stated that the current educator is going to do a room arrangement and determine what is needed from there.</p> <p>There are three buses that transport the children from school at three different times. The children arrived and were able to move freely to their choice of activities. Some of the children were interested in art materials while others were playing with blocks. By the time all three buses arrive, the children will prepare to go outside. The educator talked about using a project approach to planning with the children moving forward where they are only at the facility for a short period of time. Journaling the progress of those activities would be a great way to document. It is also recommended to display more pictures and the children's work on the walls.</p> <p>It is recommended to have storage for the outdoor materials. As you are still required to have learning centres in the winter months, you can still use some of the summer materials such as trucks or blocks that are weather resistant, etc...It is to licensing's understanding that bins were provided however have gotten broken since they were purchased. A storage bin like the one in the other license would work perfectly. However, the care of all materials to ensure proper storage after use would be the responsibility of the educators.</p> <p>All documentation for licensing was easily verified. It is complete and organized.</p>
