<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon arrival, the children in both classrooms were observed eating lunch. The educators were observed supervising the children while they ate. After eating, the children put away their lunch boxes and engaged in free play activities. Children were observed reading, coloring, playing with magnetic tiles, and action figures. A group of children were observed sitting at a table with an educator while engaging in coloring activity.</p> <p>Later, a verbal prompt was given to the children to transition from "free play" to "stations". The educators were observed helping the children clean up and were heard praising the children. The educators in the pre-school classroom were observed setting out invitations to play and invited the children to find a "station" once they were done cleaning up. During this time, the children in the afterschool classroom were observed building forts with the help of the educators. The educators were observed taking out building accessories such as tablecloths, tape, cushions, and pieces of the couch to allow the children to engage in imaginary play. The educators were actively engaged in the children's activities.</p> <p>Later, the children in the preschool aged classroom were observed sitting in the "cozy corner" while reading a book with an educator. The educator was heard asking questions to the children as they read. The children were heard making compromises for materials and the educators were heard encouraging and praising the children for sharing and being kind to one another. After some time, an educator was observed prompting the children to get ready to play outside.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed toy cars, trucks, wooden building blocks, mud kitchen utensils and accessories, a teeter totter, books and sporting balls outside in the playground. Wooden structures such as a play kitchen and dramatic playhouse were observed. Please ensure that the sandbox is refilled with sand to allow for the children to have a digging surface.</p> <p>Six child profiles were reviewed and found to be complete. The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Please ensure that the daily routines are posted in both classrooms. Learning stories and pictures of the children while at play were observed in both classrooms. The parent information board was verified and found to be complete. The children's personal belongings were well stored in their cubbies.</p>
