Comments: Child to staff ratio was not respected in the 2–3-year-old group. Inclusion support workers do not count in the ratio, but all children present do count in the ratio. A second educator joined the group to correct the deficiency. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The first aid and CPR certificate in an employee's file is expired. An updated certificate must be received.

Comments: One educator has not completed her Introduction to ECE course. That educator is registered to complete her Introduction to ECE course, she is waiting for a confirmation date. Once completed, the deficiency will be compliant.

Comments: Rabbit feces and urine were on and around the table. Area was cleaned and a new cage was bought during the inspection to prevent feces from being out of the cage. Deficiency is now compliant.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Discussion with educators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - on how to respect ratio when support workers are present in the group; - employee's files must be available at all times and kept at the facility. <p>A support worker who does not yet have her first aid and CPR course is not to be alone with children. She must be with someone who has a valid certificate at all times.</p> <p>All educators have completed their 10 hours of professional learning.</p> <p>Observations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The 2-3-year-old group created art and colored. The children participated in free play and then went for a walk. When they got back, they sang songs from the song box by picking objets associated with a song. - The 3-4-year-old group went outside to play, and they did paintings with long wood and cotton tips. - One group of the school age children were at the library and the other group participated in free play. Some children were building with big foam puzzles, others were creating with Legos and tracks, others were creating books and more. They went outside and after, the educator read a book to the group. - All groups had their snack; lunch and the younger children had their nap period.
