<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Visit completed at the facility in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection.</li> <li>- The ratio was respected during the visit.</li> <li>- The daily activities are purposely planned and documented and responds to the needs and interest of each child. Learning stories, pictures and children's artwork are posted throughout the facility.</li> <li>- Indoor play area materials and equipment are varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. The materials are easily accessible and maintained clean and in good repair.</li> <li>- Outdoor play occurs daily for one hour in each four-hour block of time. Rest periods do not exceed two consecutive hours.</li> <li>- Personal belongings are labelled with the child's name, easily accessible and stored separately for each child.</li> <li>- Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained. Changing area is located one metre or less from a sink. Diaper changing procedures are posted in a visible place in the diaper changing area. Children are always supervised during diaper changing.</li> <li>- Observations: Upon my arrival the children were napping. The children that were not napping were playing quiet games. The children woke up, washed their hands and had a snack. While the children were eating their snack, the educators read a story to their group. During free play activities, the children were playing with the farm, dolls, constructing with blocks and playing with musical instruments. The educators were engaged in the children's play.</li> <li>- Discussion with the educators on their professional development hours. The educators have completed more than 50% of their required hours. Two educators are completing their ECE and 1 educator is completing their 90-hour course.</li> </ul>
