General Comments

Monitoring inspection and follow-up to a complaint completed today. Discussed with operator and staff the nature of the complaint regarding child guidance and confirmed that all staff have reviewed section 8.2 of the Operator Manual and signed off on it with a copy placed in staff files. Also discussed supervision with operator and operator reported that staff do not leave children unattended and that they do step outside the doorway of the 4 year old room to accept children when they arrive at the centre and that they are still adequately supervising children engaged in activities in the classroom.

Children and educators engaged in activities in the indoor and outdoor environments. Indoors children were working on gifts and cards for father's day. Children shared with QA Monitor their drawings and talked about their pictures and families.

Outdoors, children were engaged in play with natural loose parts and art materials. Educators were observed engaging in conversation and play alongside children.

Discussed with operator and educators ways to plan and document for infants. Individual learning webs for each child that include new language, skills, interests and curiosities are a great way to highlight infants learning and development. Learning stories can be developed based on these observations and support further planning including invitations to learning and materials that can be added to the environment.
