General Comments

Follow up monitoring inspection and inspection of renovated room conducted today. Children and educators were observed in the outdoor play area.

As discussed during last monitoring inspection- the dome in the preschool outdoor play area must have adequate surfacing (at least 9 inches of mulch or gravel, 6 inches of shredded rubber). Please note that grass is not appropriate surfacing for this climbing structure. A maximum of 6 children should be using the structure at one time, Direct supervision is required.

Also discussed requirements of being a designated early learning centre and requirements for staff to complete professional learning hours. Professional learning opportunities support educators n their roles as professionals and in creating high quality environments and experiences for children.
