Comments: Preschool area- plastic dragon cracked at top near head. This item must be removed from the outdoor play area. Grass and weeds overgrown in infant outdoor play area, this creates areas where children cannot play, especially young children who may not be walking yet. This area must be mowed and maintained regularly.

<p>Comments: 2 year old room- materials for open ended art were not accessible to the children, but stacked in containers with tight fitting lids. QA Monitor suggests that an invitation be placed on the table during free play for children to have access to open-ended materials during free play time and not only during an educator directed activity.</p> <p>Preschool room- During time of inspection, art table and materials were inaccessible to children because there were chairs stacked on the table.</p>

<p>Comments: Mulch under stationary equipment in school-age play area packed and spread to not meet requirement for appropriate depth. Mulch is to be raked daily ahead of children using the equipment to ensure the requirement is met.</p>

<p><b>General Comments</b></p>
<p>Monitoring inspection completed today. It was noted during the inspection that the cleanliness of materials and equipment in the classrooms has greatly improved. A balance of indoor and outdoor play was observed.</p> <p>As discussed during inspection: Masks are required for all children 2 years of age and over when in common areas i.e going to the bathroom. As well, attendance records can serve as a daily log, additional daily log is not required.</p> <p>Pop cans observed on tables in classrooms. QA Monitor discussed with operator role of educators to model healthy choices for children.</p>
