Children and staff were observed in the indoor and outdoor environments during today's inspection. Outdoors, educators were observed spread out throughout the play area engaging with small groups of children in reading, drawing with chalk, playing in the sandbox, and on the climbers.

Indoors, school age children were engaged in free play with materials in the classroom.

Daily schedule in 2 year old room is very structured and rigid. Recommendation to create a daily schedule that Page 2 of 3
