Children and educators were observed during nap time, snack, and outdoor play. Outdoors, children were engaged in a variety of play and educators were observed interacting with children at their level.

As discussed, additional surfacing required in the preschool play area under the climbing dome and caterpillar climber.

Please forward a copy of updated snack menu to Quality Assurance Monitor.

Continued conversation regarding providing open-ended art opportunities for children and a variety of materials. Additional paper required in many of the classrooms. As discussed a variety of sizes, textures, colours and shapes of paper can inspire children.

Materials, equipment and props that inspire and support painting, drawing, mark making, construction and modelling should be accessible and available daily in both the indoor and outdoor play areas.
