Monitoring inspection completed today. Children enjoyed indoor and outdoor play today, and shared with QA Monitor about their experience playing in the rain.

Enhancements to the indoor play environments were noted with a variety of new materials available for the children to engage with, including a variety of blocks, books, and gross motor materials.

Documentation posted reflects recent activities and learning. Having documentation posted at the children's level in interest centres has provided children with an opportunity to revisit past experiences and discuss and reflect with their peers and educators. Ensure educators sign their name to their documentation.

Educators were observed engaged in play and conversation at the children's level.
