General Comments
<p>Monitoring inspection completed today. Children were engaged in outdoor play during inspection. Outdoors Educators were observed throughout the environment engaging with children in play and conversation.</p> <p>Improvements to some indoor play areas including a variety of materials that reflect children's current interests and documentation of learning were noted. As discussed, other indoor environments require enhancements so that a welcoming and engaging play space is available for children. Preparing invitations to learning ahead of children's arrival, and displaying materials in ways that invite exploration supports children in valuing their environment and can minimize challenging behaviours.</p> <p>Discussed documentation of children's interests and learning with administrator. Recommending that educators are careful not to project their own views onto the children, but rather to focus on their observations of what children are saying and doing and using those observations when they write. The CAT Reflective Guide has questions for observation, conversation and reflection that can support educators.</p> <p>Ensure clutter on ledges and shelving is cleared regularly.</p>
