All classrooms had an abundance of documentary evidence posted on the walls for the children to re-visit their learning experiences.

All classrooms child-to-staff ratio were within regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act.

All educators were observed using positive child guidance techniques when experiencing undesired behaviors by redirection along with taking a child aside to help them work through their feelings.

Educators in all classrooms were observed engaging with the children at the child's level.

Despite the snowy weather, the children had opportunities to play outside, and the infants went on their daily walk.
