Comments: Infant room- Children's water cups were observed in the diaper changing area. Cups are to be stored away from the diaper changing area.  Upstairs bathroom and downstairs hallway sinks- Garbage can covers are unclean and require a thorough cleaning or replacement.  Upstairs bathroom- window sill dusty and unclean. To be cleaned.  Downstairs bathroom- Toilet seats in both stalls are stained and need to be replaced. Step stool unclean.

Comments: 3-4 year old Preschool room downstairs- outlet cover missing from outlet in dramatic play area.

Comments: Light colored area rugs throughout classrooms unclean and require deep cleaning or replacement. Infant room- clutter observed on shelves in children's sleep area. 2-3's room down- Clutter observed on shelves and teacher's desk at entryway to room. This was previously discussed during last monitoring inspection. Removing clutter and debris from shelving and desks ensures the room is clean and creates a more welcoming environment for children and families.  3-4's preschool down- Window sills dusty and unclean. Require cleaning. 2-3's and 3-4's preschool rooms down- paint on walls throughout both play environments are chipped and require repainting as gyprock is exposed in some places.

Comments: Preschool Outdoor Play area- front pedal missing on 2 person tricycle. Tricycle is to be removed until fixed or replaced. Infant play area- Tall grass requires mowing. School age area- Wooden shelf on mud kitchen is broken. Shelf is to be removed or replaced.

Comments: Preschool room up- Kitchen centre dusty and requires cleaning.

Comments: School-age play area: Mulch is compacted around stationary equipment and requires raking to ensure it is appropriate depth.

Comments: Playground checklist available and accessible to staff but is not being completed. As discussed with Administrator on-site, this is to be completed to ensure the safety of the children.

Comments: Infant Room- Glass cleaner on shelf in sleep area. Must be locked under lock and key. Upstairs bathroom- Mr Clean disinfecting spray in spray bottle on shelf above diaper change area. Bottle was mislabeled as bleach and water. Must be locked under lock and key. 3-4's Preschool room downstairs- Shaving cream observed on shelf in play area. To be locked and used under direct supervision.

Comments: Preschool room up- One incident log form dated June 14 not complete or signed by parent.			

### General Comments

Monitoring Inspection completed today. Children and educators were observed in the indoor and outdoor play environments during the visit.

Documentation and open-ended creative art were posted throughout the learning environments. Documentation observed during inspection today demonstrated work in progress, highlighted children's recent interests and learning, and celebrated children's accomplishments.

General Comments

Recommendation by licensing staff to have more trucks/ construction vehicles available for children in the outdoor play environment. During inspection, only 2 were observed available to the children in the outdoor play area.

For children with an extreme allergy management plan, it is recommended that a copy be placed with their epi-pen and in their file. As discussed during inspection, staff members must be aware of children who have a life-threatening allergy and their allergy management plan.

2 new staff files were checked during inspection and were complete.
