Other educator in the room was not properly dressed to go outside and had to go back inside and dress in winter clothes. Once the Educator came back outside, she went back inside again to gather kleenex and other items. In order to maintain child-to-staff ratio, educators are to be ready to go outside the same time the children are, bringing all necessary supplies with them when first going out. Discussed with Operator and Educators during inspection.
