General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 30, 2025.

Children were observed engaged in both indoor and outdoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently interested in exploring the new outdoor play area centres and materials, participating in nature walks and community outreach, celebrating "Fun Fridays," learning Mandarin, dancing, and engaging in active outdoor play.

Outdoors, educators were seen playing an active role in children's activities. Outdoor play is offered for at least one hour in each four-hour block when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. The daily routine is posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are clearly displayed in prominent locations. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted.

Upon arrival, both parents and children are greeted with enthusiasm. The facility offers a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are clean and free from clutter. Toxic products such as chemicals and cleaners are locked and inaccessible to children.

Diaper changing procedures are posted and visible to staff, and drinking water is available throughout the day. Allergy information for any child is posted. The infant outdoor play area is used separately or at different times than that of other age groups.

Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, reflecting the activities and interests of the children. Educators provide opportunities for curriculum to be extended indoors and outdoors and efforts are made to bring the natural world into the classroom.
