## **General Comments**

## Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including gross motor play, dramatic play, puzzles, music and movement, playdoh, exploring soft blocks and animals, and exploring the light table and magnetic tiles.

The infants were observed during lunch time routines. Educators were observed assisting them with their meals and engaging in meaningful conversations.

Purposeful planning is evident throughout each environment through documentation, photos, group portfolios, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (gross motor play, superheroes, playdoh, the Wheel on the Bus, Old MacDonald, the human body, and snow).

Big Twos Room: QA Monitor discussed getting age-appropriate art materials out on low open shelving for the children to have easy access to materials. Currently, art materials are stored in a closed container within a drawer. When materials are easily accessible it encourages all children to create.

Fours Room: QA Monitor discussed with staff that hairbrushes must not be shared between children. Hairbrushes are to be labelled, stored separately and used only for the intended child.

Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines and before mealtimes.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

Daily Infant Information sheets were observed to be completed throughout the day.

Incident Logs are completed when needed and signed by parents/guardians.
