General Comments

A follow up to the renewal inspection was conducted today. All outstanding orders for compliance were completed and the facility is recommended for license renewal, pending the recommendation from the Office of the Fire Marshall.

Discussed with administrator and educator the small school-age room on the left adjacent to the stage. This area is measured play space and the window in this area is part of the required window measurements. This area must be set up with materials for the children to interact and engage with and not used a break away spot for staff. If going to be used by staff, then this will reduce the number of approved space in the school-age area. As area will not meet the requirement for regulation 30 (4) Indoor Play area (windows). During the follow up inspection the administrator indicated they would set up with materials for the school-age children.

Discussed with administrator and educator in infant room to ensure that at the end of the day that the water table, located on the infant deck is tipped on its side to prevent the accumulation of water during a rain storm.
