General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon. Infants were observed finishing up their snacks. The two-year-olds were observed during a sensory activity, involving Oobleck (corn-starch & water). Children were observed exploring the slimy substance with their hands. The preschool children were observed playing outside. The preschool children were later observed entering the building to wash their hands, before heading back outside, for their afternoon snack. Afterschool program – A ukulele was heard, coming from the afterschool room. The younger afterschool children were later observed outside, with their educator, awaiting the older kids to arrive. A conversation was had with administrator regarding the fire exit door, up by the kitchen. This door is to stay unlocked, during operating hours, as directed by the fire marshal. A conversation was had with administrator regarding the outdoor play area, and potential items that could be added to this area. We chatted about real household kitchen items (pots, pans, spatula, etc.) Administrator stated that a mud kitchen has recently been ordered. QAM observed the new sensory break out room. Children are to be supervised in this room. A conversation was had with administrator regarding ideas for this room. Some of the ideas that were discussed: children's yoga pictures and a yoga mat, breathing exercises, fidgets, and bubbles. A conversation was had with administrator regarding educators and first aid certificates. All educators are required to have their 16-hour Standard First Aid with CPR Level C Certificate, issued from a recognized provider. Educators are not to be left alone with children, without their completed Standard First Aid with CPR. Please review page 26 in Operator's Manual for more details.
