A Monitoring Inspection occurred on January 17, 2025.

During the inspection, children were observed participating in indoor and outdoor free play, as well as transitioning from snack time. Proper handwashing was observed during this transition. Steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular-sized toilets or sinks.

Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in ice hockey, exploring bubbles on the snow, and creating art with balloons and paint. Outdoors, educators play an active role in facilitating children's activities.

The facility maintains a daily incident log. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour during each four-hour block of time when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. The license, current inspection report, and monitoring reports, along with any orders for compliance, are posted in a clearly visible and prominent location. A daily routine is posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are prominently

displayed. Life-threatening allergies are also posted for awareness.

Books have been selected that reflect the children's current interests, and the facility provides a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are kept clean and free of clutter.

The changing area is located within a meter of a sink, and diaper changing procedures are posted in a visible location for those performing the change. Drinking water is provided throughout the day, and the infant outdoor play area is separate or used at different times than other children.

The curriculum offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy are incorporated into the indoor environment. Additionally, portfolios are being completed with the children, and the children have access to them.
