Comments:	Only the administrator and one staff member holds a one-year Early Childhood Education certificate. The administrator and 50% of educators must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent.  On the day of the renewal follow-inspection (in July), the educator in charge shared proof that one of the educators was accepted into the ECE Microcredential program starting in the fall of 2025. During today's monitoring inspection, the educator in charge confirmed that the individual has now started the course.  The operator must send a copy of the certificate after completion, to meet the 50% of educators with ECE requirement.

The educator must ensure that children's daily attendance records are completed promptly and accurately. The educator immediately added the child's name and the arrival time of the child.
