The plan provided by the administrator to meet this regulation, back in January 2024, has not been successfully achieved. The Quality Assurance Monitor requested a new plan in November 2024. In May of 2025, the plan was not yet been achieved. On the day of the renewal follow-inspection, the educator in charge shared proof that one of the educators was accepted into the ECE Microcredential program starting in the fall of 2025. The operator must send a copy of the certificate after completion, to meet the 50% of educators with ECE requirement.
