## General Comments

It was a very sunny crisp morning when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a monitoring inspection visit. When licensing staff arrived, the children were engaging in free play activities. Some children were playing in the building centre creating ramps and forts with larger wooden blocks while other children were playing in the dramatic play centre making food.

When it was almost snack time the operator told the children that they had five more minutes to play until snack time. After five minutes, the operator began to sing a clean up song and the children began to clean up the materials that they were playing with. Licensing staff heard the operator say, "I wonder where the books go," and "I see two buses on the floor, I wonder where they go?" The children immediately picked up the buses and the books and put them away in their appropriate place.

The operator was observed hugging and comforting a child when they child banged into the side of a table and began to cry. The child was quickly comforted and then moved on to the next activity.

The operator was observed redirecting some running by a child by asking the child if they could jump up and down to burn off some of their access energy. The child eagerly jumped up and down, on the spot, ten times and then twirled around a couple of times before sitting down with a sigh of exaggerated exhaustion.

The outdoor play environment was very welcoming and full of natural materials. The play set has a round swing, very low to the ground, has lots of protective surfacing; however, the protective surfacing has been packed down and will need to be tilled up so the depth of the surfacing will measure as per the manufacturers manual. The operator relayed to licensing staff that the swing will be removed for the winter months and then put back out in the spring.
