General Comments

Arrived to perform annual renewal inspection. Children were playing outside upon my arrival. NBCC student doing practicum placement was also present during the time of the inspection.

Outdoor play area was observed to be clean, safe and in good repair. A large swing was accessible to children however it was not developmentally appropriate for the young children in attendance. This swing was removed by the operator.

The infants were often held by the operator and student, they also placed them in a wagon with a lap belt and pulled them around the yard. Educators were observed to be very responsive to the needs of all the children and facilitated sharing, named emotions and helped young children to communicate with one another. Children enjoyed the mud kitchen, hula hoops, shovels and play cars throughout their outdoor play time. Positive behaviour guidance was observed at all times.

Observed transition from outdoor play to lunch time. Children in attendance brought their own meals and snacks from home. Proper mealtime etiquette was model by operator and student and pleasant conversation took place. New infant in attendance was still settling into their new routine and the operator provide them with extra support and reassurance which helped to put the infant at ease.

Proper diaper changing procedures were observed. Tables and changing table were sanitized properly and handwashing was observed. Bathroom paper towel was empty during time of inspection and should be replaced. Transition to quiet time was smooth and children appeared to have a strong routine. Infants were provided a crib and other preschool aged children rested on cots.

General Comments

A new dog has been introduced to the home, all annual checks and immunizations were up to date.

Some items were missing from children's files, the operator was able to produce the missing documents during the inspection and has place them in the proper file.

Some water bottles for the children were placed out of reach during the time of the inspection. The operator moved this water to a lower table within the play space during the inspection. Water is to be accessible to children at all times.

Materials in the home were age appropriate and allowed for a variety of play-based learning experiences. Documentation of learning was posted on the walls of the home with artwork and pictures of the children participating in activities. The children appeared well adjusted to the home and have established an attachment with both the operator and the student.
