General Comments Monitoring Inspection: Children engaged in play both indoors and outdoors this morning. Educators observed reading, singing and engaging in meaningful conversations with the children. Left recommendations with the educators and operator how to display materials in a way that is inviting. Utilizing the tops of shelving to display books, toys and other interesting materials will invite children to engage in play. Discussed setting up purposefully planned invitations on tables that support the children's interests throughout the day. Having art materials easily accessible to the children on low open shelving or through an invitation on the table will encourage children to get creative.
